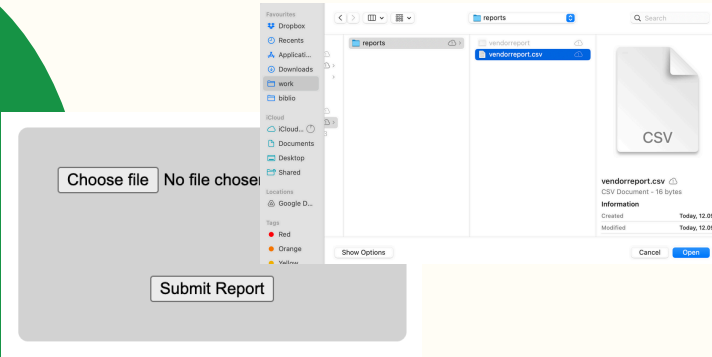

Step 2. Upload the data

a. A dedicated portal

Upload your data on this website: <https://vendor-report-app.onrender.com> in three simple steps.

1. Authenticate with Google
2. Sign the privacy agreement: protect your data and ensure it's only used to show you how your spending supports the local solidarity economy.
3. Click on **Choose file** and navigate to your report file.
4. Click **Submit Report!**
